Container Dispensing Capability

U. S. EPA Container and Containment Regulations, August 16, 2006

Included in the Container Design Standards, that all registrants must meet by August 16, 2009, is a description for container dispensing capability:

- The container must allow the contents (1) to pour in a continuous, coherent stream (without “glugging”); (2) to be poured with a minimum amount of dripping down the outside of the container
- Applies to liquid pesticides in containers that have capacities of less than or equal to 5 gallons (18.9 liters)

Many container styles with the EPA identified 63 millimeter closure, including pinched handle, vented handle, and standard F Style currently meet the performance standard “...(1) to pour in a continuous, coherent stream.”
